#### 2017 Foundation enrolments open

The time has come to enrol your child for school next year. If your child **turns 5 on or before the last day in April 2017**, they are due to start school next year. All children starting school need to have their **immunisation history statement**. It is wise to complete the 4 year old immunisations now so that the statement is up to date. Schools start planning now and need to know this term about the numbers of Foundation students for next year. Just contact the school to arrange a time to enrol asap. If you know of other children in our area who will start school next year, could you let them know to contact the school now and arrange the enrolment?
