HELPING OUR STUDENTS LEARN

In order to help our students make a great start to their school day, they need a routine that develops their independence and a focus on learning. In order for that, parents will need to leave their children at their line-up before school and collect them afterwards from a special place you choose in the yard. Students should bring their iPads into their classrooms when arranged on their own.

Students should **not arrive at school before 8:30am** in the mornings unless they are in the Before School Care program. This is because we provide yard supervision from 8:30 and because our toilets are accessible from 8:30 onwards.

Our teachers need to be preparing for the school day before school and parents will need to arrange to talk with our teachers at the end of the school day or at arranged times.

These 3 things will certainly help students to develop our 4 Thinks and so progress well in their learning.
