## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

### FETE

1. We are holding our fete tomorrow on **Fri 9<sup>th</sup> November** from **12:30 to 2:30pm**.
2. All children are required to attend the fete until 2:30pm.
3. Foundation students need to be accompanied preferably by an adult or by an older brother or sister.
4. It is suggested that students have a named shopping bag or such to carry items purchased or won at the fete.
5. It is suggested that students have a named wallet or purse to carry their money.
6. It would be great if the students had their money in small notes and coins.
7. The silent auction and raffle will be drawn at 2:15pm in the gym.
8. All school bags will be locked in our buildings until 2:30pm. Unfortunately, we will not be able to unlock any buildings until 2:30pm.
9. We suggest that no iPads are brought to school on this day.
10. If a parent wishes to take their child home at the end of the fete at 2:30 they will need to sign them out by **signing** next to the child's name on a class list from the **class teacher between 2:15pm and 2:30pm**.

### KINDER TRANSITION

We are improving our transition process this year by holding **6 Wednesday afternoon sessions** for the new Foundation students and **interviewing each family individually** to gather important information about each new student to make their transition to school as supportive as we can. So far, our new Foundations for 2019 have spent 2 sessions together here at school. If you have a child or know of a child ready to start school next year, please contact the school office as soon as you can to make a time to enrol and include your child in the important transition sessions on Wednesday afternoons from 1:45 to 2:45.

### 2019 TRANSFERS AND NEW ENROLMENTS

If your child/ren are **attending another school** next year [except those in year 6] and you haven't yet informed the school, we ask that you let us know as soon as you can, so that we can exclude him or her when forming our 2019 classes.

If you know of any children intending to **start at Mossfiel next year**, please encourage them to contact our school office, 9749 1227, as soon as they can so that their child/ren can be included in our classes for next year.

### BOOKLISTS FEES

Last night at our School Council meeting, we reviewed our budget for 2019 and we saw the need to raise our fees to **\$185 per year**. This is due to a rise in the cost of all the materials that the students use throughout the school during the whole year. Our fees have not risen for 2 years and this is a catch up on the cost of materials and services.

Because our **Foundation students** will be using the school-provided iPads next year, they are required to pay a **\$30 Technology levy** on top of the \$185, making the annual fees [for Foundation students only] **\$215 for the year**. This \$30 Technology levy will be added to each year level fees, as we are able to provide the iPads and laptops in subsequent years.

As well, we decided to again offer **2 chances to win \$100 credit** at our school for each student who has their fees **paid in full by Wednesday 19 December and winners will be drawn at assembly on Thursday 20 December**. Booklists will be issued in the next week or so and fees can be paid at our school office any school day during office hours.
