Hello to the Mossfiel school community,

We have had a fabulous term of remote and flexible learning- it has been fantastic to see students continue to engage with the work on Google Classroom and on See Saw. We appreciate the ongoing support of our families throughout this process and being part of the learning process for your children. We have sent home an award to thank you for your support- it's been a learning experience for us all.

It's been fantastic having our Foundation-2 students return to school this week, and hearing how much they are enjoying being back at school. I have really enjoyed having the opportunity to visit classrooms and had the chance to say hello to all of the classes who are back onsite learning. We have been really happy with how our drop off and pick up process has been going, and appreciate how all of our families have adhered to physical distancing requirements and our staggered start and finish times. It's been great to see our teachers out on the gates walking with our students to their classrooms, and also bringing them to the gate at the end of the school day. I've loved the opportunity to meet some of our parent community so far, and look forward to continuing this throughout the term.
